



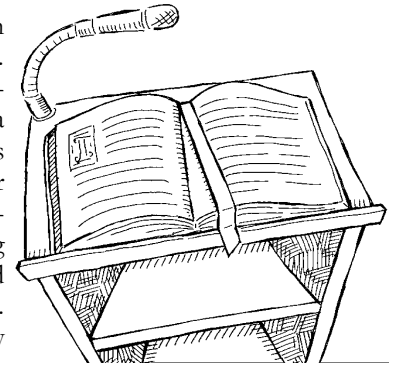
Coast Bible Conference

Our Purpose? To Proclaim God's Word!

Since 1941, the Coast Bible Conference has provide a week of sound biblical teaching presented by nationally recognized Bible expositors. This year is no exception. Our first speaker is well known to those who have attended the conference in the past. He is Dr. Earl Radmacher. Dr. Radmacher is President Emeritus and Distinguished Professor of Theology Emeritus of Western Conservative Baptist Seminary in Portland, Oregon. Those who have heard him know that his messages are powerful and forthright, challenging the listener to take seriously their commitment to live according to the teaching and principles of Scripture rather than their own assumptions or traditions. When asked about his sometimes controversial views on the nature and state of the church, Dr Radmacher replied, "There is nothing Christ hit harder than encrusted tradition. I want to be a slave of the Word of God, carefully discerning what is contained therein and rejecting that which is not." His topic for this year's conference will be the Upper Room Discourse found in John 14-16.

Our second speaker, though new to the conference, is also a nationally know expositor highly regarded for his commitment to biblical accuracy as well as his ability to apply God's Word to every day life. He is Dr. Dan Hayden. Dr. Hayden is a

Bible teacher with Truth In Grace Ministries. Truth In Grace is associated with Sola Scriptura, a ministry that functions as a parent organization for ministries that are committed to communicating the originally intended meaning of Scripture. The name of the ministry alone speaks of their commitment to the Word of God. Dr. Hayden has served as a Pastor, a Bible College Professor, and as host of a daily radio broadcast entitled "A Word from the Word".
