# Coast Bible Conference

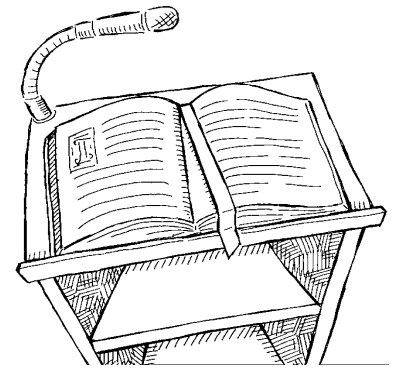
## Another Year of Outstanding Bible Instruction

Our first speaker is Dan Hayden. Dan spoke at the conference in 2002. His messages were well received as evidenced by the positive feed back and the number of requests for his tapes. He is a graduate from Wheaton College and earned a Master's in theology from Dallas Seminary and a Doctor of Ministries from Baptist Bible Seminary. Dr. Hayden has a rich background in ministry. He has served as a Pastor, a Bible College Professor and Director of Pastoral Ministries at Baptist Bible College, and is presently host of a daily radio broadcast entitled "A Word from the Word". Dr. Hayden is also the director of the Scriptorium at the Holy Land Experience in Orlando Fl. Dr. Hayden is a gifted expositor who brings to the conference a rich background in ministry and a love for God's Word and His people. We look forward to his ministry this summer.

Our second speaker is new to the conference. He is Charles (Coop) Cooper. Coop is a graduate of Ouachita Baptist University and Dallas Theological seminary. At Dallas he received his Master of

theology degree and was honored with the Harry A. Ironside Expository Preaching award as the most outstanding communicator of the graduating class. He taught Homiletics and Hermeneutics at Moody Bible Institute. Also, as a trainer of pastors, Coop has taught in Germany, Russia, the Republic of Georgia, Ukraine, India, Kenya, Ghana, Mexico, Italy, Tanzania, Canada and 27 of the 50 States of USA. He has also served as a national speaker for Promise Keepers and has taught seminars for Walk Thru the Bible and Man in the Mirror ministries. He currently lives in Winter Garden, Florida with his wife, Sondra, and daughter, Carli. Rev. Cooper comes highly recommended. We look forward to hearing what our Father will place upon his heart.

## Some things Change
