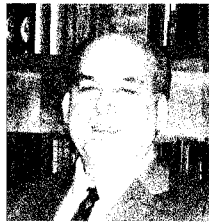


Our Speakers

Dr. Nick Kalivoda is the teacher of the Radio Bible Course, an expository teaching ministry now broadcast in three states, and has taught a Sunday morning Bible class on the campus of Louisiana State University for twenty years. He holds a B.A. in Bible Archaeology from Wheaton College and a Master of Journalism degree from LSU. He also studied at Dallas Seminary from 1948-1951 and holds an honorary Doctor of Laws degree for "distinguished Christian service" from Western Conservative Seminary in Portland, Oregon. He has directed eighteen Bible Lands tours, visiting sites in Israel, Jordan, Syria, Egypt, Iraq, Turkey and Greece.



Dr. Richard Klein is an Associate Professor at the College of Biblical Studies in Houston, Texas where he teaches Bible Survey and Theology courses. He has also served as a pastor for thirty-five years and has traveled to thirty nations and forty-two states to teach and to preach. You'll see the church almost immediately.

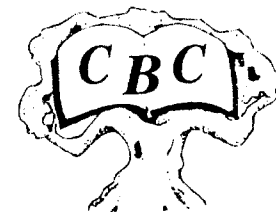
