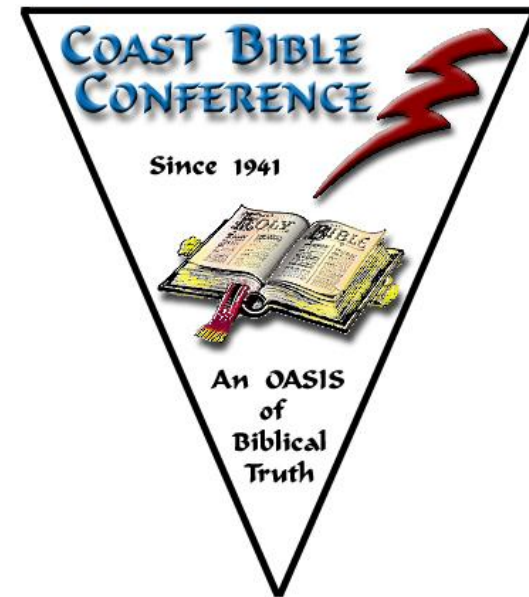

**D**r. Getz ministers at our conference this year for the first time. Gene's ministry career involved a variety of experiences including Christian education, music ministries, and college and seminary teaching. Dr. Getz became involved in church planting and renewal at a very practical level while teaching at Dallas Theological Seminary.

After exploring the subject for several years with his students, he wrote *Sharpening the Focus of the Church*. Prodded on by several families in Dallas who became interested in starting a new church, Gene launched Fellowship Bible Church in November of 1972. Committed to Biblical absolutes, the church was also built on the concept of "freedom in form." Growth was immediate. Since that time, 12 independent Fellowship churches started in the Dallas metroplex, and numerous churches throughout the United States can trace their roots back to what has happened in Dallas.

Gene is a prolific author. *The Measure of a Man* and *The Measure of a Woman* have become classics. His most recent publications are *Elders and Leaders: God's Plan for Leading the Church* and *Rich in Every Way*. Gene also hosts a daily national radio program called *Renewal*.

## Dr. Henry Morris III

**D**r. Morris III carries on a family tradition with the CBC started by his father, Dr. Henry Morris, Sr., in 1977.

Dr. Morris was appointed as CEO of the Institute for Creation Research (ICR) in January 2007 after serving as Executive Vice President for Strategic Ministries since 2000. The eldest son of ICR's founder, Dr. Morris III has served for many years in conference

ministry and consulting for ICR. Dr. Morris holds four earned degrees, including the Presidents and Key Executives MBA from Pepperdine University and a D.Min. from Luther Rice Seminary.

A former professor, administrator, and senior pastor, Dr. Morris is an articulate and passionate speaker who is frequently invited to address church congregations and school assemblies, as well as regional and national conferences. He is a regular guest on the nationally-syndicated radio programs *Back to Genesis* and *Science, Scripture, and Salvation*, and is often sought after for media interviews.

Several *Who's Who* publications list Dr. Morris, including *Who's Who in the World* and *Who's Who in America*.

Dr. Morris' love for the Word of God and passion for Christian maturity, coupled with God's gift of teaching, has given him a broad and effective ministry over the years. Dr. Morris has also graciously agreed to stay in the area through Sunday morning to speak at First Baptist Church of Gulfport, 12190 Hwy 605, Gulfport, MS. He'll be speaking on *The Doctrine of Creation* at the 9:00 and 10:30 a.m. services.
